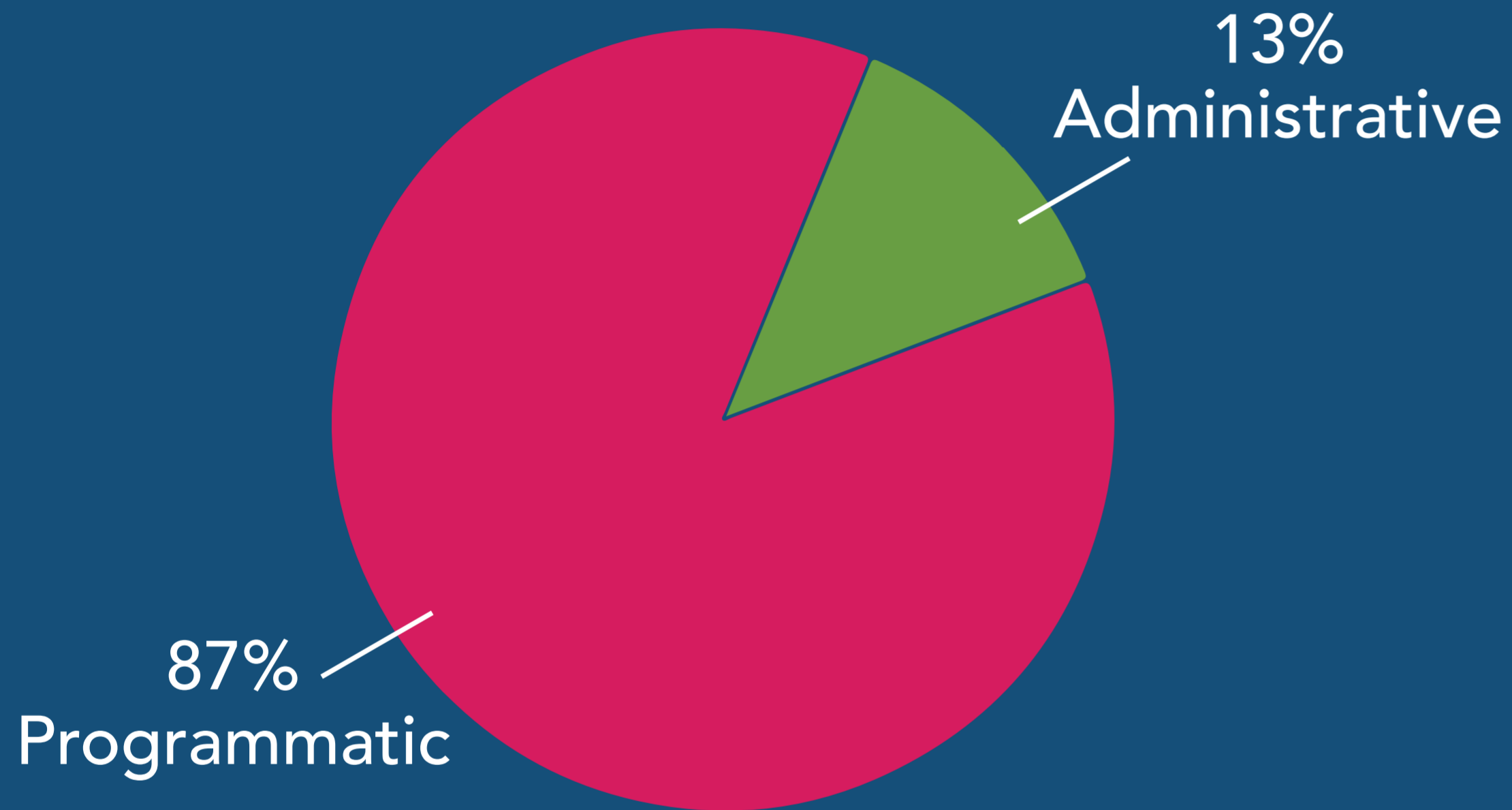

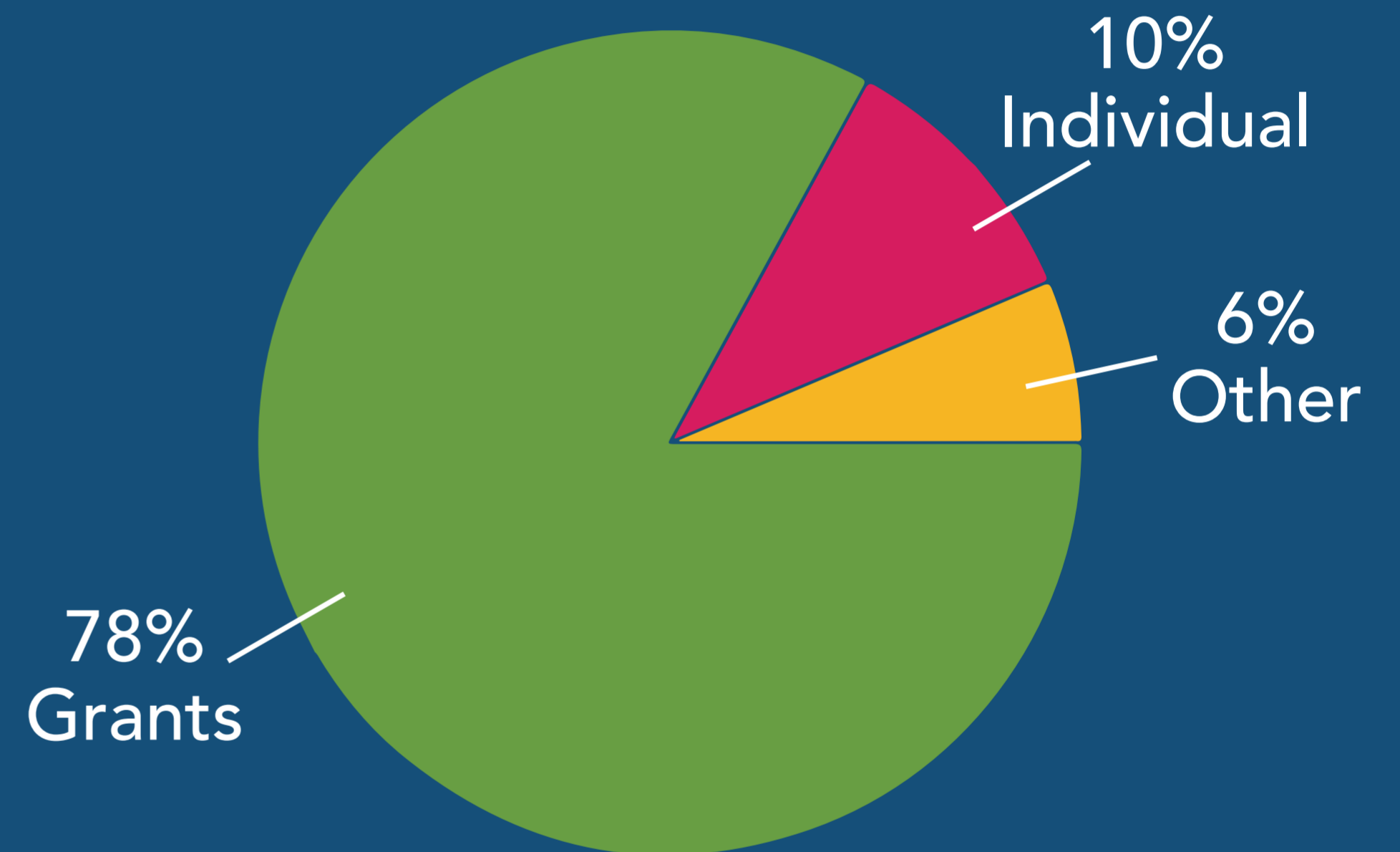

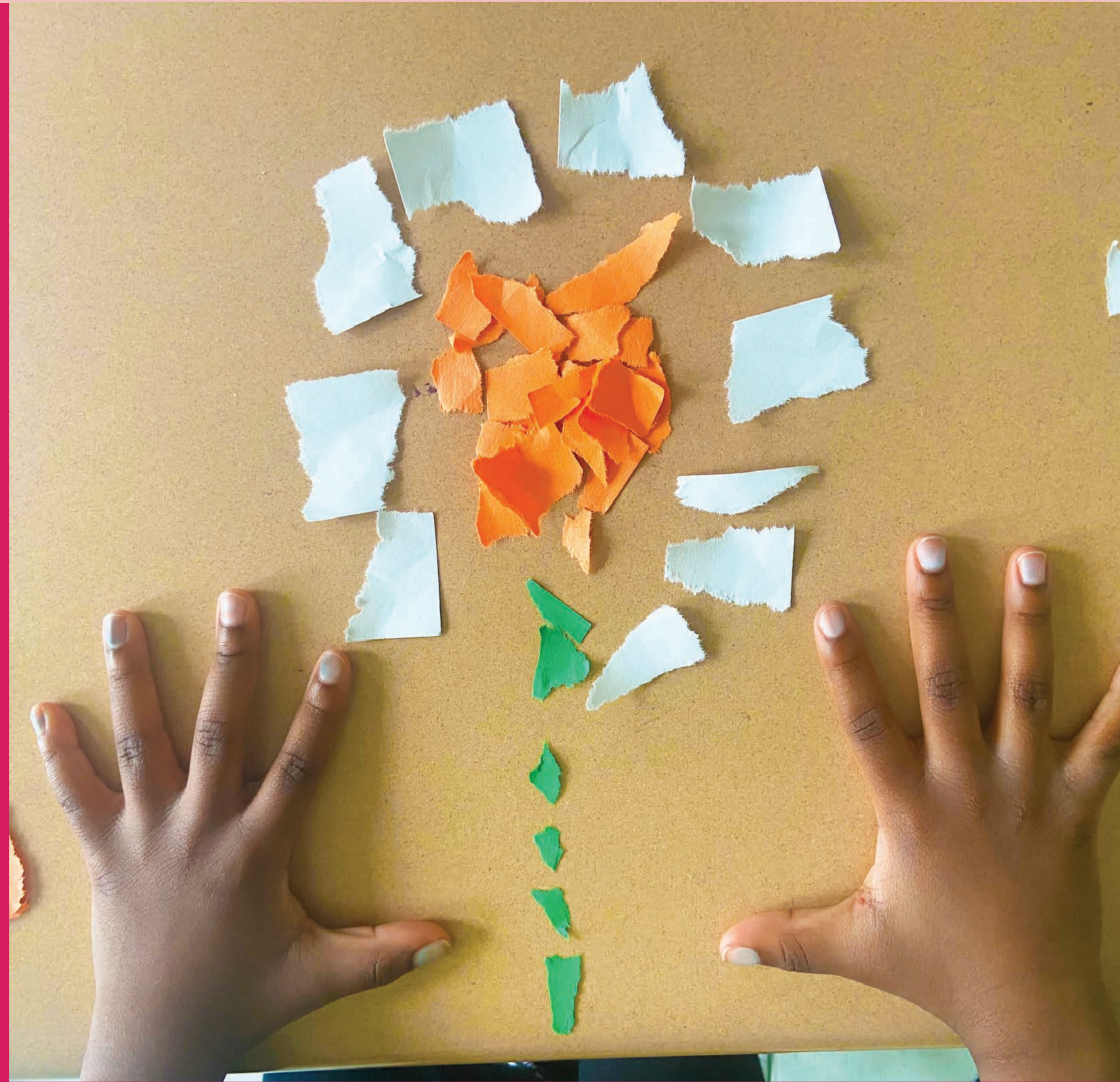

DISTRICT IMPACT

Systems change is never fast, BUT here are some highlights that have been years in the making.

- **40%** increase in the number of Fine Arts Teachers since adoption of 2018 Fine Arts Plan
- **14** fine arts teacher positions **SAVED** through advocacy
- City Schools allocates **\$12,000,000** in federal funds to expand fine arts and athletics programs





With the launch of the Baltimore Youth Arts Advocacy Council in 2021, Arts Every Day created an innovative leadership opportunity for eight Baltimore City high school students. These students researched the school district to better understand what barriers exist to bringing the arts to EVERY school and drafted recommendations to improve equity and access.

Their findings not only matched the AED mission and outreach, they were presented to district and state leaders to inform policies and procedures. Your generosity funded stipends for this next generation of arts advocates. Thank you for helping them to find their voice!
